<b>1. CAUSE AND EFFECT QUESTIONS</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• What caused this event?</li><li>• What are the consequences of this choice?</li><li>• What hidden motivations could have generated this effect?</li></ul>	<b>5. PERSONAL AND REFLECTIVE QUESTIONS</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• What do you think about this situation?</li><li>• How would you feel if you were in the main character's shoes?</li><li>• What would you do in a similar situation?</li></ul>
<b>2. COMPARISON QUESTIONS</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• How is A different or the same as B?</li><li>• What are the pros and cons of this situation?</li><li>• If we were to merge A and B into one thing, what would it look like?</li></ul>	<b>6. IMAGINATIVE QUESTIONS</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• How would you explain this topic a child?</li><li>• What kind of creative solution would you propose for this situation?</li><li>• How would the situation change if considered from an optimistic or pessimistic point of view?</li></ul>
<b>3. QUESTIONS FOR CHANGE</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• What would happen if we changed a rule / an event / the traits of a certain character?</li><li>• How might this situation change over time?</li><li>• How would you imagine this situation in a different environment? E.g. your city, ancient Rome...</li></ul>	<b>7. ANALYSIS QUESTIONS</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• What are the stages that make up this situation?</li><li>• What key elements contribute to the success or failure of this project or situation?</li><li>• How does this mechanism or thought work?</li></ul>
<b>4. QUESTIONS ABOUT SOLUTIONS AND ACTIONS</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• How can we solve this problem?</li><li>• What could we do to improve the situation?</li><li>• What concrete actions can we propose?</li></ul>	<b>8. MULTIPLE PERSPECTIVE QUESTIONS</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• How would a person who lived 100 years ago see this situation?</li><li>• What would an expert think about this topic?</li><li>• How would a child or an elderly person react to this problem?</li></ul>
