Classroom Rules

YOU ARE ALLOWED TO USE AI TO:

- Look for ideas and inspiration for writing texts, arguments, presentations.
- Ask for explanations of complex concepts or doubts about study content.
- Generate short drafts of texts that will then be personally reworked and corrected.
- Get feedback on exercises you've already completed.
- Complete other tasks as instructed by the teacher.

YOU MAY NOT USE AI TO:

- Copy AI-generated texts and present them as your own.
- Conduct checks, tests or assignments to assess personal level.
- Avoid studying or replace your critical thinking with AI.
- Using AI to evade personal responsibility or deceive the teacher.

STUDENT COMMITMENTS:

- I am committed to using AI to support, not replace, my efforts.
- I make a point of citing the use of AI when I make significant use of it.
- I am committed to developing my personal thinking also with the help of AI.

IF I HAVE ANY DOUBTS ABOUT THE WORK YOU HAVE SUBMITTED, I MAY ASK YOU TO:

1. *Tell in your own words the content of the text you have submitted, point by point.*
2. *Explain the meaning of some words or expressions in your text, to understand if you know them and use them regularly.*
3. *Summarize your text, directly in class, and present it orally.*
4. *Write a similar topic to the assignment to see how you do it without outside help.*
5. *Produce a brief reflection on how you did the task. Tell me how you worked, what tools you used, what difficulties you had, if you asked anyone for help.*
