

GUIDELINE STRUCTURE FOR WRITING AN ARTICLE: ADVANTAGES AND DISADVANTAGES

INTRODUCTION

Introduce the topic and prepare the reader for the comparison.

- Initial description: briefly explain what it is about.
- Current context: Indicates why the topic is relevant today.
- Purpose of the article: It anticipates that positive and negative aspects will be examined.
- (Optional: Ask a question or use a phrase that stimulates curiosity.)

BODY

Analyze the pros and cons of the topic in a balanced way.

Advantages:

- List 2 or 3 main positive points.
- Explain each point with clear reasoning.
- Add concrete or hypothetical examples.

Disadvantages:

- List 2 or 3 main negative points.
- Explain each point with clear reasoning.
- Add concrete or hypothetical examples.

CONCLUSION

Summarize and take a personal or proactive position.

- Short summary: summarize the most important advantages and disadvantages.
- Personal rating: express your opinion.
- Proposal or closing opening: Suggest a possible solution, advice, or leave room for further reflection.
