Rephrase this sentence in your own words.

Provide a practical example.

Clarify a concept that seems unclear to you.

Connect this idea to a personal experience.

Connect this concept to a current event.

Ask the group a question about what has already been said.

Explain why this concept is important.

Find a weak point in the argument expressed.

Suggest a way to apply this idea in real life.

Briefly summarize what has been said so far.

Add a detail or piece of data that strengthens the argument.

Give a historical or literary example related to the topic.

Propose an alternative to the concept just expressed.

Relate this concept to another school subject.

Make a comparison with an opposing or contrasting idea.

Cite a famous person or author that connects to this theme.

Ask the person who spoke before for clarification.
